Guidelines, Eligibility, & Application

Artwork Guidelines:

- * One entry per artist.
- * Entries must have been created within this last year.
- * All entries must be show ready. Paintings, drawings, and photographs must be framed and wired for hanging. Saw tooth hangers are not acceptable.
- * Artwork must have been created by a Pasco County high school student.

Eligibility:

- * High school students in Pasco County, Florida.
- * Heritage Arts Center Association accepts or rejects entries at their discretion.

Application:

Application must be completed online <https://heritagearts.org/annual-nereim-scholarship-award-application-process/> by March 31, 2026.

Presentation:

All entries must be show ready. Paintings, drawings, and photographs must be framed and wired for hanging. The students must attach the label provided in the application to the back of the artwork. See attachment for details.

Art Show Categories & Media / Technique:

- * **Drawing**; pencil, charcoal, Conte crayon, chalk, pastel, ink
- * **Painting**; watercolor, acrylic, oil, ink wash, gouache
- * **Mixed Media**; 2- or 3-dimensional work including two or more media
- * **Photography**; printed image minimum size 8"x10"
- * **Digital Art**; printed image minimum size 8"x10"
- * **Sculpture**; e.g., ceramics, wood, plaster, stone, wax, metal, papier-mache

Procedure:

- 1 Submit application including jpeg or png to <https://heritagearts.org/annual-nereim-scholarship-award-application-process/> beginning January 15 ending March 31, 2026.
- 2 **HACA** will announce the students whose artwork will be in the show and notify all students who applied to be in the show by April 6, 2026.
- 3 The selected artwork must be delivered to the **Hugh Embry Library** in Dade City show ready and properly labelled for identification between these dates April 7 -15, 2026. Check this link for library hours. <https://www.pascolibraries.org/about/locations-and-hours/hugh-embry-branch-library/>
- 4 The show will be open to the public beginning April 18 through May 2 at the **Hugh Embry Library**. Check the library's website for hours. <https://www.pascolibraries.org/about/locations-and-hours/hugh-embry-branch-library/>
- 5 **HACA** will host an award ceremony at **Hugh Embry Library** from 12 to 2 p.m. on Saturday, May 2, 2026, at which time will announce the winning artwork, and present awards to those students. Refreshments will be provided for all who attend.
- 6 Students will take their artwork home with them after the ceremony on May 2.

DISPLAY READY ARTWORK

Preparing Fine Art & Decorative Art Entries for Exhibition

Fine Art & Decorative Art (2D)

(Items that can be hung on wall)

Artwork should be framed excluding gallery wrapped canvases.


- **Framed items** must be ready to hang using secure screw eyes and wire.

- **Gallery wrapped canvases** should be ready to hang using secure screw eyes and wire.

Gallery wrap is a method of stretching an artist's canvas so that the canvas wraps around the sides of the stretcher bar or strainer bars and is secured to the back of the wooden frame, where the hardware (staples, tacks, etc.) is hidden.


- **All artwork must be labeled with the exhibitors name on the back of the piece.**

- All three-dimensional artwork must be received **installation-ready**. Provide a base if necessary for structural support.
